
Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Days - These will be starting this week. You will note that we have also provided alternative dates for each sports day, should the weather be unfavourable. 


Eid Mubarak to all our families who were celebrating last week. I hope that you all had a lovely time and ate lots of lovely food!




Key Messages and Reminders
