

## **Dear Parents/Carers**

## **Holiday Homework**

Over the holidays, we have set pupils a task to complete on Matheletics and Spellodrome, which I would strongly advise you to encourage your children to use. I go on about reading so much, as I and many educators believe the ability to read well, is crucial for success in school and in later life. The pupils have also been asked to do some work around healthy life styles, (mental and physical health and diet) please talk to them about the importance of sleep, hygiene and eating well. MORE than anything else, read with your child, hear your child read, help them to learn their spellings and their times tables.
