Dear Parent /Carer

It is with regret that I have to write this letter, in regards to the issue of attendance. You are aware of the importance both the school and the government place on daily attendance, yet despite this, there have been an increased number of families requesting time off during term time. I would like to reiterate that no time off during term time will be authorised for holidays or visits overseas.

Taking a child out during term time interrupts the learning of the whole class and teachers have to spend time helping children catch up when they return. This is having a detrimental effect on their learning and our attendance which has dropped due to persistent absentees which is when a child has missed 10% of their schooling.
