It's getting chilly now so I would like to start off by reminding all parents that you **MUST** send your children in with a coat/jacket every day. We will be keeping an eye on this so please make sure you comply.

### **Parent Curriculum Sessions**

We will be holding Parent Curriculum sessions in the evening from 7pm - 8pm on Monday 18th October (for lower primary) and Thursday 21st October (for Upper Primary) in the Barn. These sessions are later on as we would like to share with you some very important information without the disruption of young children. We thank you for your understanding in this matter.

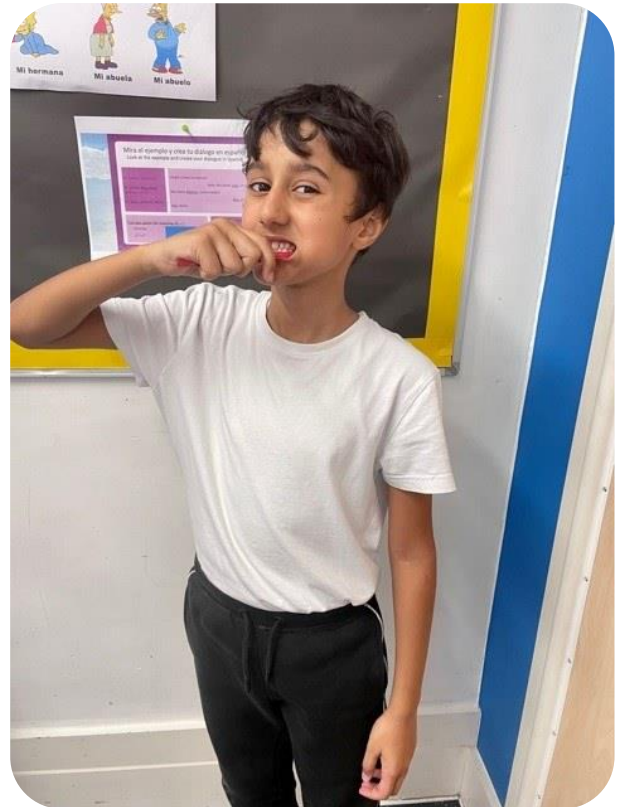




### Teeth Brushing Month
