Dear Parents, Guardians & Carers,

I hope you all had a lovely Eid last week; the children have been telling us all about their festivities (mainly the food) and seem in great spirits!

As you are aware, England is slowly coming out of lockdown. Today marks the opening of indoor restaurants, the rule of 6 being extended to indoor areas, entertainment venues like cinemas, theatres and bingo halls being re-opened etc.

However, restrictions in schools still apply! We as a school still have to follow certain guidelines to ensure the safety of our pupils and staff. As a school we will continue to carry out risk assessments and consider the rates within our local area. We would still require parents to wear masks when collecting your children, one adult at a time and please avoid extensive conversations on the playground.


