Dear Parents, Guardians & Carers,

What a day! While the weather may not suggest it, we are fast approaching the summer break. I hope you were all able to access your child's report cards last week and have received your parent meeting invitations. As all standard tests have been cancelled nationally, we will not be including any results. We have included the results from the reading data which we were able to collect during and after lockdown. This is for year 2 to 6 only.

We are very aware that pupils have gaps in their learning, which will take time to address. As a result of this, we have targeted teacher development to ensure the curriculum moves at the pace that is required. We have carried out a needs analysis to see how the last year has impacted the children and put in place interventions accordingly.

The end of term arrangements are as follows:

This year we will be having a staggered finish to the last week of term. This to enable a smooth transition to take place and for year 6 to be able to say good bye on their last day at primary school. Below you will see that the finish time is 11.30am - 12.00pm.
