Key Messages & Reminders

Just so you don't forget...

Marathon Challenge

The aim of the challenge is simple – run or walk a total of 26.219 miles throughout the term. This will of course not be in one go, but instead spread out across the term through regular sessions of physical activity. Each lunchtime will count for 0.5 miles, every hour-long PE lesson your child takes part in will be an additional 1 mile to add to the total. As your child progresses through the challenge, they will receive motivational stickers when they achieve certain landmarks. Finally, when the marathon is completed, they will be presented with a medal as recognition of their amazing achievement. They will then be able to confidently say to their friends and family that they have 'run/walked a marathon.'

Peer Mentoring

We have been working closely with Hannah Ford (Mental Health Practitioner) to develop our peer mentoring programme. As a peer mentor the children will support their peers through resolving conflict on the playground, making friends, supporting children when they feel alone or down, being an active listener, providing advice and leading mindfulness sessions. The year 5 pupils have been eagerly completing their application forms and some children have been selected to attend an interview next week. Once the children have been recruited, the children start an 8-week training programme with Hannah to enable them with the skills and knowledge to effectively start mentoring peers in September. We look forward to introducing you to the new Peer Mentor team soon and working alongside the school community to provide pastoral care for all children should they need a listening ear or guidance.
