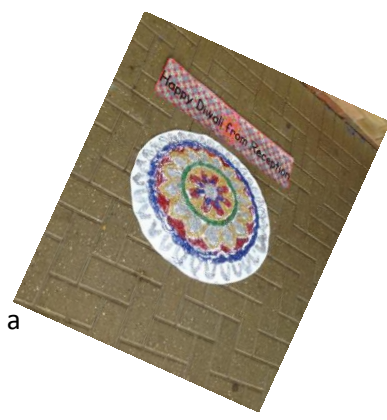

PE Kits & Lunches

Many children are in school without their P.E. kit on the required day and parents then have to deliver the clothes. Similarly, if your child has a packed lunch, they should be dropped off to school in the morning with their lunch. It is disruptive to all the children and their learning process, not simply your child, when we have to ring the classrooms so that items can be collected.
