## Dear Parents/Carers

I am really pleased to be informed by a parent studying at East Berkshire College, that our school website has been recognised as a supportive site full of helpful documents. I have been updating many of the policies this term so please have a look. Policies and documents include anti-bullying policy, e-safety policy, unacceptable behaviour policy and curriculum plans etc...

In September, the school had an INSET day on 'Talk for Writing.' Wexham has been using Talk for Writing for many years but we wanted to refresh our approach so that we can be truly inspiring. In the New Year I would love the opportunity to share this with you, so that you too can see the three to four week approach we take for each topic. With this in mind I have arranged monthly 'Sneak a Peek,' sessions. These are designed to provide demonstrations on how we teach or approach key areas of the curriculum, as well as allow parents to have an experience of their child's learning journey. They will be practical and not us telling you what to do. Dates for Spring 1 are:

- Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January 1:30pm to 2:45pm – Model guided Reading session, followed by create a reading area.
- Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> February 1:30pm to 2:45pm – Model Talk for writing session and create a story writing environment
- Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January 1:30pm to 2:45pm – Glorious Maths challenge and model lesson

In addition to this, I have arranged information sessions for the new assessment at Wexham. These will be the same as the session we ran in October but in different languages. The dates are as follows:

- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 4:00pm - Assessment at Wexham (in Urdu)
- Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> January 4:00pm - Assessment at Wexham (in Punjabi)
- Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> January 4:00pm - Assessment at Wexham (in Polish)
