Dear Parents/Carers,

What a week of sunshine and rain! It seems impossible to predict the weather, so please be prepared for all conditions. We have moved our **Early Years sports day** to Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June, fingers crossed the sun will be shining. **Key Stage 1** sports day will be on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June, followed by a picnic on the field. Parents have had letters regarding this, but as a reminder the pupils will do a heptathlon first, followed by races. Parents are invited to attend the races, followed by a picnic.

**Year 3 and 4 will have their sports day** on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July, this will follow the format as above but will be held at Wexham Secondary School. Parents are invited to join the sports day from 10:15am and stay for the picnic afterwards at Wexham Secondary School. **Years 5 and 6** will also have their sports day on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July again at Wexham Secondary. Parents are invited to join pupils from 11:30am. However the Years 5 and 6 picnic will take place at Wexham Primary and NOT Wexham Secondary School. Pupils will be escorted back to school and onto the field where they can have their lunch. If parents wish to take pupils home and not join in the picnic, they can take them from Wexham Secondary school but must ensure they are signed out.

Parents please remember to stay on the parent side of the line during sports day and to ensure younger siblings do not run onto the track or across to where the pupils are seated. Please also remember to bring your trainers for the parent race. Finally, we ask you respect the school grounds by not smoking and by placing all your litter in the bins provided.

June and July are packed full of events and so I am going to list them below:

- Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June 1:30pm Year 4 Viola concert, parents are invited to attend – you should have received a letter. Parents to come to the main office.
- There will be a choir and concert and performance on 8<sup>th</sup> July between 11:00 – 12pm. Letters to follow
