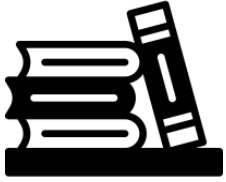

Our Enquiry curriculum is divided into termly themes covering History, Geography, Science, Art & DT with a cross-curricular approach. Year groups will study a different topic for each half term related to these which is shown on the curriculum map.

Our themes are:

Our curriculum intent for history is that children will:

- Develop a coherent knowledge of Britain's past and that of the wider world in a chronological narrative, gain historical perspective, understand the complexity of people's lives, the process of change, the diversity of societies and the relationships between different groups, own identity and challenges of their time, and develop a wide historical vocabulary.

Our curriculum intent for geography is that children will:

- Have a good knowledge of location of significant places, understand physical and human characteristics and their interdependence, and develop a wide geographical vocabulary.

Our curriculum intent for science is that children will:

- Develop sound scientific knowledge and conceptual understanding, understand the nature, processes and methods of science, learn to think, speak and write like a scientist, understand the uses and implications of science, and develop a wide scientific vocabulary.
