Dear Parents/Carers,

The final week of school is upon us and yet there are still so many exciting things ahead. First of all, I just wanted to update parents on our recent visit from Ofsted. Under the inspection rules, we are not able to share the outcome of the report until it has been through Ofsted's quality assurance team. This takes up to two weeks. It is sent to school and then published online. Due to the summer break being next week the report will now not be completed until September. I understand that this is frustrating; I will send all parents a copy when we return and post a copy to Year 6 leavers. What I will say is a big thank you to all the parents who said such lovely things about the school, staff and pupils. Your comments were so heart-warming, which was noted and reassured me that we are moving in the right direction. I also wanted you to know how wonderful the children were. The inspectors spoke to lots of pupils during lessons and on the playground, during which the pupils came across so happy, safe, confident, self-assured and polite. Every single inspector commented on how well-behaved they were. I have said it before and I will say it again, they are super stars!

Speaking of super stars, our Year 6 pupils will be leaving us next week. They have been a real delight to have around the school and so many of them have such big hearts. Having performed so well in their end of year SATs, they have been busy performing their version of Aladdin this week. It was very enjoyable and great to see the pupils speaking and acting so confidently. Next week they will all go to Chessington as their last trip together and have a leaver's assembly on Tuesday 19th at 9:30am followed by their end of primary party. I wanted the pupils to know we are very proud of

them, each and every one and wish them only the best of experiences in their secondary schools. We will be very sad to see them go.

Year 6 will be having their Leavers Disco on Tuesday 19th July from 5-6:30pm. I would be really grateful if you would ensure that your child is collected promptly after the party, as in previous years we have had staff waiting around for up to an hour after the party has finished until children are picked up. Clearly this is not acceptable and we would be grateful if children could be picked up promptly.



Due to the Ofsted inspection our scheduled parent consultations were cancelled and these have now been rescheduled for Friday 15th July and Monday 18th July. Please be aware that due to the limited amount of time

before the end of term, there will only be time for short five minute consultations in order to discuss any questions around your child's report. If you have any issues accessing your child's report, or require a printed copy for you or a partner, please ask. Please note that the reports will <u>not</u> open on mobile devices, you will need to access them through a laptop or desktop. There is a letter explaining the report grades attached to the online report, a copy has been sent out today.

A quick timetable for the last week:

- There will be no clubs running in the last week of term, so please ensure that your child/children are collected promptly at the end of the day.
- Breakfast Club will be running Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday next week only.
- Get Active finishes on Friday 15th July 2016 and there will therefore be no after school provision next week.

There are also members of staff who are saying goodbye to Wexham this year. Miss Blore, Miss Khalil and Miss Gosling have moved to London and while I think they should stay, clearly a two hour drive is too far. Mrs Done has suffered some poor health and decided to resign from her post as Deputy Head and move abroad. Miss Ormond will also be going to Qatar to teach. Miss Winters and Miss Stanley will return home to Canada and Miss Free will be moving to Devon to be closer to her partner. Mr Valentine has moved home recently and will be teaching in an independent school. Mr Lewis has been working with us on a contract from an agency and while we would have liked to keep him on, certain clauses do not enable this. Therefore, we have supported his transition into working at Slough Children's Trust. Finally, Mrs Conroy having been here for all her teaching career is moving to be closer to home so that she can be there for her gorgeous little girl.

Mrs Bhullar will be going on maternity leave in July to have her first baby and Miss Rogers will be walking down the aisle to return as Mrs Manning. We wish them both the best and many congratulations in advance.

We wish them all the best and thank them for all the work and support they have given to Wexham during their time with us. We have a very strong team ethic at Wexham and everyone has worked exceptionally hard to ensure that the school moves forward in supporting the best possible teaching and learning. I would like to thank all the staff for their hard work and commitment to the school and the pupils. You are aware of the pressures placed upon schools nationally and the amount of work teachers are expected to complete and yet they do it. Often leaving work at 6pm to ensure the pupils' books are marked and lessons are planned well. This was no more apparent than on the strike day when staff opted not to strike so that parents and pupils would not be disrupted so close to the end of term. This is despite them feeling passionately about the issues presented in the strike. They worked incredibly hard during the inspection to ensure that all the pupils' good work was seen. I would like to thank them and wish them a restful summer break.

I am however very excited about the term ahead. We have many great activities planned for the pupils and invested heavily in more reading materials for them next term. I will share with you our ideas next term. The staff will start the year on 1st September during which time teachers will have key training. The team for next year is strong with a number of experienced teachers joining our school, with lots of different skills to offer.
