Words with 'ou' sounds, for example young, touch

Words where the ' $\mathbf{y}$ ' sounds like ' $I$ ', for example mystery

Words with 'ei', 'eigh' or 'ey' for example weigh

Words with an s sound spelt sc, for example science

Words which end 'gue' or 'que' for example league or mystique

Words with a 'ch' sound, for example chef, machine

Words with a $\mathbf{k}$ sound spelt 'ch' for example chemist or character

Words, with a stressed syllable at the end, that double the final consonant before adding a prefix, for example preferred
