

Written Statement of Behaviour Principles



- 1. Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued, respected, and learn, free from the disruption of others.
- 2. Staff and pupils understand the expectation to be ready, respectful and safe.
- 3. All pupils, staff, governors and visitors will not be discriminated against unlawfully.
- 4. Staff and pupils understand that there are always consequences to their decisions.
- 5. Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times.
- 6. Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy.
- 7. The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff.
- 8. Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions.
- 9. Exclusions or suspensions will only be used as a last resort, please see the Exclusion Policy.
- 10. Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life.

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the full governing board annually.
