Assemblies take place in the hall every Friday, LP will start at 2: 20– 2:40, UP will start at 2:45-3:05. You will be partnered with a teacher in the opposite phase, so please work together to share the preparation for the assembly and tailor to your key stage. Please ensure the slides are minimal and we keep words on the slides to a minimum.

This is still a new routine for LP and the older children will need reminding of our expectations, consistency of language and behaviour will be the key determiner in how children behave during these times. Please go through these rules with the children before, during and after.

Our norms...

- All children to line up single file ready for assembly.
- Shirts to be tucked in and hands by sides.
- Quietly and respectfully walking to the hall and sitting down with their legs crossed.
- Ready and listening to the teacher.
- Children are to walk out in the same manner.

Correct and model behaviour when needed. If children need more practice with these routines, keep practicing.

Please have calming music playing whilst children walk in and out of assembly.

Leave 5 minutes for star of the week celebrations, teachers please give certificates at the beginning of assembly to teacher leading.

Children to walk to the front and hold their certificate for everyone to see – have moment of reflection with children, let's be inspired by your peers, think about how you will strive for excellence next week.
